



Intro to the Religious Arguments Part 1



MY DEFINITIONS

- **RELIGION** = Man's efforts to achieve right relationship with their God.
- **FALSE RELIGION** = Anything that alters the Truth as revealed by God in the Protestant Bible.
- **CULT** = Any religious movement which denies the orthodox beliefs of Christianity. Usually involve the following...per Steven Hassan in his book "Combatting Cult Mind Control":
 - > Behavior Control: An individual's associations, living arrangements, food, clothing, sleeping habits, finances, etc., are strictly controlled.
 - ➤ Information Control: Cult leaders deliberately withhold or distort information, lie, propagandize, and limit access to other sources of information.
 - > Thought Control: Cult leaders use loaded words and language, discourage critical thinking, bar any speech critical of cult leaders or policies, and teach an "us vs. them" doctrine.
 - ➤ Emotional Control: Leaders manipulate their followers via fear (including the fear of losing salvation, fear of shunning, etc.), guilt, and indoctrination.
- OCCULT = Religions based on knowledge of the hidden or paranormal...usually associated with demonic pocession, communication with the dead, and supernatural power over others.
- **DENOMINATION** = Variations of belief within protestant Christianity ...i.e. Baptist vs Lutheran vs Presbyterian vs ??.
- **SECT** = A dissenting or schismatic religious body; especially one regarded as extreme or heretical.



Guiding Principles

- 1. Focus on bringing clarity to the Gospel by Introducing them to Jesus.
- 2. Don't assume they believe what their religion teaches. Respect them enough to let them say what they believe.
- 3. False Religions and Cults are complex...
 - ➤It can take years to truly understand...don't expect to become an expert.
 - Learn enough to be able to communicate effectively and to bring clarity about the major tenets of their beliefs vs True Christianity.
 - ➤ Witness to them but don't worship with them.
- 4. The Cross will offend but don't seek this...try to build bridges!
- 5. No one usually cares what you believe until they know you love them! At a minimum, respect is a love language.
- 6. Patience...How long did the Lord work on you before you believed?




Cautions

- 1. Do not assume that you would never fall prey to false truths of false religions and cults.
 - ➤ The Bible describes false teachers as smooth talkers from within your own fellowship. Romans 16:17-20
 - ➤ There is a reason people fall prey to their enticing lies.
- 2. BE BEREANS...Test those who call themselves "Christians"!
- 3. It is good to go in "twos" if you can.
- 4. Demonic occults can be dangerous. Research, inquire with elders and pray prior to deeply engaging.
 - Figure Greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world! I John 4:4

What if you have never heard of them before?

- Most false religions are similar at a high level but vary on the specifics.
- Focus on clarifying questions in the following domains:
 - ➤ Definition of their God vs the Bible
 - ➤ What do they do with Jesus?
 - ➤ How do they discern truth...Whom do they Trust?
 - Is Truth governed by man or God?
 - One source of truth through one man or many?
 - What methods do they use to determine if it is true or not?
 - ➤ How are they "saved" in their beliefs?
 - By man's works or by God's works?
 - Does it deal with the depravity of man sufficiently?
 - How does it deal with the topic of Faith? Sovereign Grace?
 - Look for the checklist and the treadmill of their religion.
 - ➤ How do they deal with those who disagree with them?
 - God says those who are truly His will treat their enemies with love.
 - Are they open to criticism or closed to any questions?









What should you look for as openings?

- Any sign of seeking truth.
- Poor in Spirit.
- Two way open dialog at a minimum.
- Bridges from what they care deeply about to the real Gospel.
 - >Examples:
 - They want to go to Heaven...then find out why they believe their religion will get them there. Show them why the Bible says faith in Jesus will guarantee the result.
 - They believe in right and wrong...why...on what basis? How does their list compare to what Jesus gave us?
 - Their religious leader is important to them...how do they know this person was honest and trust worthy? What test have they given them? Could they stand up to the same tests given to Jesus?




