- 32 "If you love those who love you, what credit is *that* to you? For even sinners love those who love them.
- 33 "If you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is *that* to you? For even sinners do the same.
- 34 "If you lend to those from whom you expect to receive, what credit is *that* to you? Even sinners lend to sinners in order to receive back the same *amount*.
- 35 "But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High; for He Himself is kind to ungrateful and evil *men*.
- 36 "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.
