- "For John the Baptist has come eating no bread and drinking no wine, and you say, 'He has a demon!'
- "The Son of Man has come eating and drinking, and you say, 'Behold, a gluttonous man and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!"
- "Yet wisdom is vindicated by all her children."
