Isaiah 46:1-4

- 1 Bel has bowed down, Nebo stoops over;  
Their images are *consigned* to the beasts and the cattle.  
The things that you carry are burdensome,  
A load for the weary *beast*.
- 2 They stooped over, they have bowed down together;  
They could not rescue the burden,  
But have themselves gone into captivity.
- 3 “**Listen to Me**, O house of Jacob,  
And all the remnant of the house of Israel,  
You who have been borne by Me from birth  
And have been carried from the womb;
- 4 Even to *your* old age **I will be the same**,  
And even to *your* graying years I will bear you!  
*I have done it, and I will carry you;*  
And I will bear you and I **will deliver you**.
